Many of them are self-described libertarians, drawn by the idea of a currency that exists outside the control of governments. Some were so taken with the concept that they launched Bitcoin businesses, such as exchanges where people can buy the coins or exchange them for dollars.

CEO of BitInstant, a service that transfers cash to Bitcoins

His first purchase was 500 BTC at \$3 each. He bought thousands more when the value hit \$20

Founded Bitinstant to allow its customers to purchase using Bitcins in over 70,000 stores, including Wal-Mart and Duane Reade

Wears a ring engraved with a code that gives him access to the electronic wallet on his finger. Friends tease him that a thief could cut off his finger to get the ring. Hence his nickname, "Four-finger Charlie."

CEO of Tradehill Bitcoin exchange

Accidentally deleted 800 Bitcoins when he wiped his computer clean in 2010, losing a commodity that today would be worth tens of thousands of dollars. It wasn't too big a deal, though; as one of Bitcoin's first investors, his initial purchase of 5,000 coins was for 20 cents each
