Created four years ago by a person or group using the name Satoshi Nakamoto, Bitcoin is a virtual currency that can be used to buy and sell a broad range of items—from cupcakes to electronics to illegal narcotics. The surge in a Bitcoin's value has made millionaires out of people who loaded up on them early on—however briefly. Many of them are self-described libertarians, drawn by the idea of a currency that exists outside the control of governments. Some were so taken with the concept that they launched Bitcoin businesses, such as exchanges where people can buy the coins or exchange them for dollars.

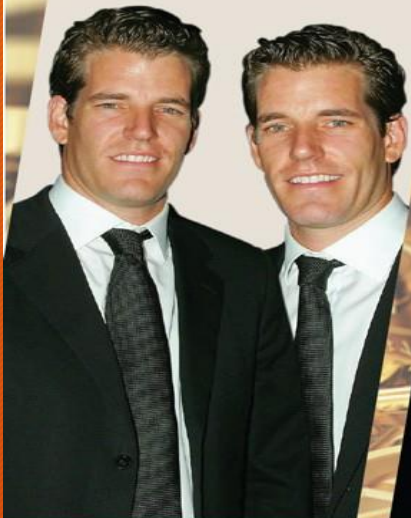

stores, including Wal-Mart
and Duane Reade

Wears a ring engraved with
a code that gives him access to
the electronic wallet on his finger.
Friends tease him that a thief
could cut off his finger to get the
ring. Hence his nickname,
"Four-finger Charlie."

He is said to hold over
USD45 million
worth of Bitcoins



JERED KENNA

Age:
30

CEO of Tradehill
Bitcoin exchange

Accidentally deleted
800 Bitcoins when he
wiped his computer
clean in 2010, losing
a commodity that
today would be worth
tens of thousands of
dollars. It wasn't too
big a deal, though; as
one of Bitcoin's first
investors, his initial
purchase of
5,000 coins was for
20 cents each

He is said to hold over
USD30 million
worth of Bitcoins
